Our governors, staff and pupils make Lingham Primary School a pleasure to be part of, with shared principles of friendship, trust and mutual respect leading to high achievement.

At Lingham Primary School we undertake to comply with all regulations in regard to Child Protection and safeguarding duties.

We comply with all regulations as set down by the LA, DfE and Health and Safety Codes of Practice.

The Governing Body of Lingham Primary School agreed the following statements in creating a 'no dogs' policy for the school:

Lingham School is a **No Dogs School**.

No dogs (other than guide dogs) are allowed at any time within the buildings or on school site. However, on occasion, rescue and other service dogs may be present in school as part of the children's curriculum enhancement. Permission must be sought from the Headteacher in this case and appropriate risk assessments completed and adhered to.

Parents, pupils', visitors and staff must not bring dogs onto the school site at any time **or tie them up outside any of the school gates or perimeter fencing unattended.**

All prospective employees of the school will be made aware of this policy.
